Transportation Improvement Projects on Interstate 80/94

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) would like to make you aware of the transportation improvement projects that will impact travel on Interstate 80/94 (I-80/94) in Northwest Indiana. Some of these projects have already begun and will continue throughout 2014.

Lake County

- Resurfacing sections of I-80/94 between the Illinois state line and SR 912/Cline Avenue
- Resurfacing sections of I-80/94 from Clay Street to the Toll Road/Interstate 80/90 interchange

LaPorte County

- Bridge removal project over an abandoned railroad on I-80/94 five miles east of U.S. Route 20

Porter County

- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over U.S. 20 and the CSX Railroad
- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over Bethlehem Steel Easement Road, 1.53 miles east of State Road 249
- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over U.S. 20 (exit #22) approximately one mile east of State Road 149
- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over CSX Railroad, 1.36 miles east of U.S. 20
- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over Little Calumet River, 1.54 miles west of State Road 49
- Bridge deck replacement on I-80/94 over Amtrak, .54 mile west of State Road 49

All of these projects will involve lane restrictions and since the highway carries more than 155,000 vehicles each day traffic delays should be expected – especially during the heavy weekend travel times on Fridays and Sundays. INDOT urges you to plan ahead and allow extra travel time to safely get to your destination on time.

Near the locations of the bridge projects, electronic traveler information signs will be used to alert travelers to major delays and will alert drivers of the option to use alternate routes to avoid the congestion.

We understand inconveniences during construction can be frustrating, but we thank you for your patience during construction of these important transportation projects.
